Corrado Rojac

Corrado Rojac began studying accordion in his home town, Trieste, under Eliana Zajec.

In 1994 he graduated from the Cherubini Conservatory in Florence where he was the first Italian to graduate in accordion from the Conservatorio di Stato.

Rojac was one of the first professors of accordion at any of the Italian state institutions. He teaches at the Conservatorio Tartini in Trieste.

Rojac has played in renowned music halls such as Teatro Regio in Turin, the Academic Institution Concert in Rome and the MITO Festival in Milan. Recent performances at Aspekte Salzburg and the Second Exhibition of Contemporary Italian Music at the Conservatory in Beijing.

In 2003 Rojac was accordionist in residence for the Laboratory of Contemporary of Azio Corghi at the Accademia Chigiana in Siena. In 2010 and 2011 Corrado Rojac was involved in a project regarding the new contemporary literature for accordion promoted by the Harvard University in Boston.

In 2011 Rojac recorded a CD entitled "Variazioni" for Limen of Milano that was broadcasted several times on national radio stations and brought him the "Orpheus Award" in 2012.
