Miroslav C. Ilic

Miroslav C. Ilic, born in 1988 in Prokuplje, Serbia, has gained primary and secondary music education in Podgorica, while he finished Music academy in Cetinje in the class of professor Predrag Jankovic.

As a solo performer and a part of the chamber orchestra, he is laureate on the Republic competitions (2000, 2002, 2006 and 2009) as well as at the international ones: Lazarevac, Serbia (2008), "Accordion days" Smederevo (2011), "Italia Award" Pineto (2011), "37th International meeting of accordion players" Pula (2012) when he won the Cup of the city of Pula with accordion trio as a winner of the highest score in all categories.

He has performed at many International music festivals: Harmonika fest (Montenegro), Nei suoni dei luonghi (Italy), Carniarmonie (Italy) as well as on many concerts in the country and abroad. Miroslav actively cooperates with the Montenegrin Music Center in whose organization he played several concerts, performed with the Symphony orchestra and with the eminent guitarist Milos Karadagic. He has played at the concerts organized by musical foundation "Santa Cecilia" and theatrical performances for the Montenegrin National Theater. He attended master classes with professors P. Fenjuk, V. Murza.

Since 2009 he has been working as a pedagogue at the Primary and Secondary Music School "Vasa Pavić" in Podgorica, in courses accordion and chamber music. His students are laureates and winners of the first prizes.
